What information we collect

Website Usage

We are proud of our website and we constantly seek to improve it. As part of these efforts, we collect certain information about visitors to our website. We may also keep a record of which pages you visit on our site and how long you spend on each page. This information is general data and cannot be traced back to you personally.
